Like every other industry, transport has been hit by the recession. But the impact has not been as bad as expected. To a large extent people have continued moving about the same country in similar numbers to before, showing just how vital transport infrastructure is to the economy.

The government has pledged this year to invest heavily in transport infrastructure projects across the country in an attempt to stimulate the economy. Over £6bn will be spent on Britain's motorways, with a further £35bn invested in railways over the next five years – a move designed to improve reliability, capacity and safety.

With a few green shoots now appearing, this conference could not be happening at a better time. It is clear that there is a continued need for transport investment, but at the same time demand management measures are essential to reduce the impact of transport on the environment and to alleviate congestion.

We have a super line up which includes the **Secretary for State, Department of Transport** and the head of the **Highways Agency, Graham Dalton**. We also have key speakers from the rail industry and local government. The conference will combine an analysis of the big picture with detailed suggestions on how to make improvements and learn from best practice.
